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National Educational Policy: Implementation Guidelines.

Ever since the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) was announced in July 2020, NIEPA has been engaged in advocating and supporting efforts towards planning for implementation of the NEP among the higher education institutions. Hence STC college has also been following number of guidelines of NIEPA. And taken various measures to implement NEP. The following guidelines have been framed by the institute.

1) Identifying the special education zone(SEZ)

Under the heads of NEP higher education institution in identifying the educationally disadvantaged zone in the catchment area and including the neglected group.

2) Enhancing the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER).

In order to stop the drop out ratio and enhance the gross enrolment ratio many measures have taken targeting scholarship, cash transfer, incentives to the parents, to send their children.

3) Gender disparity.

NEP has taken into account the concern of the socio economically disadvantaged group which includes female and transgender individuals. In addition, NEP prescribes to approach gender as a cross cutting priority to achieve gender equality in education with the partnership of states and local community organisations.

4) Social Group disparity.

Even after 75 years of independence there are disparities not among different geographic areas but also between socio economic disadvantaged group such as the SC and ST and minority population as well as there are gender disparities with socio economically disadvantage group in mind the recently adopted NEP 2020. Rightly recommended establishing the SEZ.

5) Promote education of Minority.

To address the two low participation of minorities especially Muslims who are the largest section of educationally backword minorities in the national education system. The minorities of HRD has taken several steps

E.g.1. financial aid to minorities. Midday meal scheme. Janashikshan Sansthan etc.

6) Inclusion of dis able students.

College has taken following initiatives to include disabled students.

- Identifying the disabled students.
- II. Adequate teachers training.
- III. Creating disable friendly infrastructure.
- IV. Technology enhancement.

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7) Increasing employability of graduate students.

In order to increase the employability of the graduate out come base education and skill base education has been promoting the college has conducted various skill development programmes for the students.

8) Encouraging research and development.

NEP emphasises multidisciplinary approach to education as well as the necessity of cultivation creative mind with the goal of developing analytical and critical thinking activities under taken.

- a) Enhancing the number of research centres.
- b) Conducting students research conference.
- c) Improving teaching students and teacher.
- d) Multi disciplinary research and community engagements.

9) Developing Indian culture.

10) Ensuring global recognition for indigenous projects.

The Government of India has notified NEP-2020 on July 29, 2020 based on Dr. Kasturirangan Committee's Report. The objective is to bridge the gap between the current system of education and what is required in the 21st century. It is to have Holistic and Multidisciplinary UG Education to produce employable graduates with integrated personality.

The Government of Karnataka had constituted a Task to suggest an Implementation Framework for NEP-2020. It had also constituted two sub-committees, one on Curriculum Reforms in Higher Education and the other on Governance and Regulations.

The Task Force has suggested NEP-2020 Implementation Framework for Karnataka. The State Government has accepted the action plan and taken steps to implement NEP-2020, as per the Implementation Roadmap suggested by the Task Force.

The Sub-committee on Curriculum Reforms in Higher Education had suggested a Draft Curriculum Framework for Undergraduate Programs in various disciplines. The State Govt. had also constituted Faculty-wise Committees to consider this draft framework to formulate program structures in their faculties. These Committees have submitted their reports. The latter were considered in the meetings of all the Vice Chancellors. The following Model Program Structures were designed for various Under-Graduate Programs in Arts, Science, Commerce and Management. The Subject Committees constituted to design and draft the curriculum in their subjects have to follow these Model Program Structures. The Terminology used in these Program Structures are s.

Discipline Core (DSC) refers to Core Papers in a Subject or Discipline

Discipline Elective (DSE) refers to Elective Papers in the core Subject or Discipline.

Open Elective (OE) refers to Elective Papers in a non-core Subject across all disciplines.

Program Structures also contain Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC), Languages, Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) (Both skills and value based). Pedagogy involves L+T+P model. Generally subjects with practicals involve L+P, while the subjects without practicals involve L+T model. The numbers in parentheses indicate credits allotted to various courses/papers as per definitions of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). Generally 1 hour of Lecture or 2 hours of practicals per week in a semester is assigned one credit. Generally core subject theory papers will have 3 or 4 credits, while practicals are assigned 2 or 3 credits.

Prof. Y. B. Koradur welcomed the distinguished dignitaries and distributed flowers to the dignitaries.




This was followed by a brief feedback session from the participants of the
